You must also arrange to have the following letters of reference sent directly to the Executive Director of AFSA by May 27th of the year of application:

1. Two letters of personal reference from individuals (no former teachers) who can attest to your character.
2. Two letters of recommendation from instructors or professors familiar with your scholastic endeavors on official letterhead stationery.
3. Writers of the letters should include their printed name, address, phone number and email address on the letter.
